Documents and completes paperwork in a consistent, accurate and timely manner complying with established agency policies.

Attends IDG meetings and facilitates communication with all members of the hospice team.

QUALIFICATIONS AND JOB SKILLS:

- Graduate of NLN approved nursing program.
- Masters Degree in Nursing from an accredited school of nursing.
- Possession of current license to practice as a Certified Nurse Practitioner in Pennsylvania.
- Current CPR certification.
- Minimum one year of varied work experience as a professional nurse and preferably in an acute care setting or a hospice setting.
- Ability to assess and respond to the needs of patients and families in varied settings.
- Proficiency in physical assessment as well as anatomy, physiology and medications.
- Basic computer and typing/data entry skills
- Ability to communicate effectively verbally and in writing.
- Possession of current driver's license and access to motor vehicle.
- Ability to work beyond an 8 hour shift when necessary.
