Position Available: Contract Speech Therapist

Responsibilities:

Assumes primary responsibility for a patient and their individualized plans of care as it relates to speech therapy. Develops, implements, updates and revises plan of care in a consistent, accurate and timely manner.

Participates in PCC/IDG meetings and facilitates communication with all members of the team.

Provides teaching and support to patients and caregivers as necessary.

Documents and completes paperwork in a consistent, timely and accurate manner complying with established agency policies.

Skills Required:

- Master of Science Degree with concentration in Speech Language Pathology Services and graduation from an accredited school of speech language.
- Certificate of Clinical Competence granted by the American Speech, Language, Hearing Association OR must meet the educational requirements for certification and currently be in the process of accumulating the supervised experience requirement* for certification. (*Note applying for certification is required upon completion of this requirement.)
- Valid PA Speech Pathology License.
- Minimum of one year speech therapy experience in an acute care or rehab setting.
- CPR Certification.
- Basic computer skills and typing/data entry skills.
- Demonstrated interpersonal skills, listening skills and organization/time management skills.
- Comprehensive knowledge of the practice of community health services.
- Knowledge of the Medicare/Medicaid and JCAHO regulations.
- Ability to communicate effectively verbally and in writing.
- Ability to work beyond an 8 hour shift when necessary.
