Position Available: Occupational Therapist (Contract)

Responsibilities:

- Assumes primary responsibility for a patient and their individualized plans of care as it relates to occupational therapy. Develops, implements, updates and revises plan of care in a consistent, accurate and timely manner.
- Participates in PCC/IDG meetings and facilitates communication with all members of the team.
- Provides teaching and support to patients and caregivers as necessary.
- Documents and completes paperwork in a consistent, timely and accurate manner complying with established agency policies.

Skills Required:

- Bachelor of Science degree and graduate from an accredited Occupational Therapy (OT) Curriculum (Prior to 1977 refer to Federal register).
- Valid Pennsylvania Occupational Therapist license.
- Minimum two years post graduate experience in acute care or rehab setting.
- CPR Certification.
- Proficiency in physical assessment as well as knowledge of anatomy and physiology.
- Ability to assess and respond to needs of patients and families in varied settings.
- Knowledge and proficient use of all durable medical equipment (DME) used for OT.
- Ability to communicate effectively both verbally and in writing.
- Ability to work beyond an 8 hour shift when necessary.
- Possession of current driver's license and access to motor vehicle.
