Positions Available: Physical Therapist *(Full Time and Part Time- 22.5 hours week)*

Responsibilities:

- Assumes primary responsibility for a patient and their individualized plans of care as it relates to physical therapy. Develops, implements, updates and revises plan of care in a consistent, accurate and timely manner.
- Attends PCC/IDG meetings and facilitates communication with all members of the team.
- Provides teaching and support to patients and caregivers as necessary.
- Documents and completes paperwork in a consistent, timely and accurate manner complying with established agency policies.
- Accepts responsibility for providing 24 hour coverage to patients/families through scheduling mechanisms – on-call, weekend and holiday coverage.

Skills Required:

- Physical therapy curriculum approved by the American PT Association or the Committee on Allied Health Education and Accreditation of the American Medical Association, or the Counsel on Medical Education of the American Medical Association. (Graduate prior to 1966 refer to Federal Register.)
- Valid PA Physical Therapy License.
- Minimum two years previous physical therapy experience preferred in acute care, rehab or home health required.
- CPR Certification
- Ability to assess and respond to needs of patients and families in varied settings.
- Proficiency in physical assessment as well as knowledge of anatomy and physiology.
- Knowledge of proficient use of all Durable Medical equipment (DME) used for physical therapy.
- Ability to communicate effectively both verbally and in writing.
- Ability to work beyond an 8 hour shift when necessary.
- Possession of current drivers' license and access to motor vehicle.

Schedule: Monday – Friday with occasional Saturday's in rotation
Flex scheduling available during work week

Miscellaneous: Must have use of personal automobile with current auto insurance
