Position Available: Social Worker (MSW) – Part Time

Responsibilities:

- Performs psychosocial evaluations and develops a plan of care in accordance with physician orders. Observes and re-evaluates treatment plan for changes in patient's condition.
- Communicates, counsels and supports patient and family members regarding the treatment plan in an appropriate and effective manner.
- Documents and completes paperwork in a consistent, timely and accurate manner complying with established agency policies.
- Attends IDG and PCC meetings and facilitates communication with all members of the team.
- Accepts responsibility for providing 24 hour coverage to patients/families through scheduling mechanisms – on-call, weekend and holiday coverage.

Skills Required:

- Master's degree from a school of social work accredited by the Council on Social Work Education.
- Possession of a current Medical Social Worker License to practice in Pennsylvania preferred.
- Minimum of one year of social work experience in a medical or health care setting, home care or hospice experience preferred.
- CPR Certification.
- Demonstrates good interpersonal skill, listening skills and organization/time management skills.
- Knowledge of the organization and community health services.
- Knowledge of the Medicare/Medicaid and JCAHO regulations.
- Ability to collect and record pertinent data under the agency's guidelines.
- Ability to communicate effectively verbally and in writing.
- Ability to work beyond an 8 hour shift when necessary.

Miscellaneous: Must have use of personal automobile with current auto insurance

Hours/Schedule:

- Part Time (22.5 hours week)
- Schedule requires some flexibility and includes weekend and evening hours
- Participates in on-call rotation
